- **56%** of respondents were female
- **73%** completed at least 1 AP course in high school
- 86% are first generation students
- **74%** are using grants and scholarships







# **Our Students' Expectations**

- 82% expect to graduate from Cal State LA
- 68% expect to prepare for exams with other students
- **62%** feel that its important that Cal State LA helps students to succeed academically
- **59%** expect to seek help from academic advisors
- **43%** expect to work with a faculty member on activities outside of coursework

#### High School Habits vs College Expectations

23% spent more than 10 hours a week preparing for class
35% worked for pay in high school
25% spent over 10 hours in co-curricular activities
32% spent more than 10 hours per week relaxing and socializing

**48%** expect to spend more than 10 hours a week preparing for class

**68%** expect to work during first year of college

17% expect to spend over 10 hours a week in extracurricular activities

27% expect to spend more than 10 hours a week relaxing and socializing

- 62% of respondents were female
- **95%** transferred from CC or JC
- 81% are first generation students
- 76% plan to graduate in 1-2 years
- 98% plan to graduate from this insitution
- 53% plan to seek help from academic advisors





#### College Expectations

**74%** expect to spend more than 10 hours a week preparing for class

> 80% expect to be working for pay

**15%** expect to spend over 10 hours a week in extracurricular activities

**22%** expect to spend more than 10 hours a week relaxing and socializing

balancing school and other commitments (work, family, etc)

#### 47%

not having enough money for college expenses (tuition, fees, books, etc)
