## a. CETL/DAT:

J. Suarez-Grant: highlighted that the campus was recognized in an equity-based teaching report for efforts in online course development, which resulted in a 23% reduction in D's, F's, and W's. He also mentioned an upcoming session on accessible course design.

- b. **ITS:** *V.Rowhani*: discussed extending library hours, high-end equipment in the library, and updates on remediation processes, including software purchases like Equidox and AI tools for accessibility. He also mentioned preparing for AI Day

- **8. Smart classroom technology survey report:** Faculty seem to need clearer instructions on using classroom technology. ITS will look into clarifying instructions and possibly addressing wireless presentation capabilities.

- **10. Al Day Planning:** Committee plans to wait for results from a faculty Al survey to finalize the day's themes and topics. Three tracks were considered to cater to different Al perspectives.
- **11. Al Detection Tools:** Suggestions were made for redesigning assignments to prevent Al misuse, to be further discussed at Al Day.
- **12.** Does RTP play a role in ensuring accessible instructional materials: Discussion on whether RTP should include accessibility compliance. Concerns were raised about faculty privacy and the verification of self-reported accessibility. It was suggested to incorporate this into peer evaluations rather than RTP directly.
